A note from our Social Worker - *Laura Steiner*

As daylight savings time approaches, it is important to ensure your child is getting enough rest. Here are some tips to help with sleep schedules this spring.

- *Focus on going to sleep rather than waking up.
- *If possible, put kids to bed slightly earlier the week prior to daylight savings time.
- *Shut off screens and devices 1-2 hours before bedtime.
- *Keep a consistent bedtime routine
- *Open curtains or blinds to expose children to sunlight when it is time to wake-up.
