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

- Mrs. Bradford & Mrs. Bushman (K) We are excited for spring and Easter and the chance to read all about it! In kindergarten we will be working on our reading strategies as we grow as readers! We will be working on reading fluency and exploring non-fiction texts.
- Ms. Beer & Mrs. Stork (1st) In first grade we are exploring nonfiction text structures and text features. We will research animal habitats, diets, adaptations, and other interesting facts and create our own nonfiction books about a specific animal.
