

Focus of the Month: SELECTING APPROPRIATE BOOKS

from Mrs. Bishop - Instructional Coach

Choose a book that is a good fit for your child! Have your child read two or three pages and ask himself/herself these questions:

~ Will it be an easy, fun book to read?

- Do I understand what I am reading?
- Do I know almost every word?
- When I read it aloud, can I read it smoothly?
- Do I think the topic will interest me?

If most of their answers were "yes", this will be an easy book to read independently by them self.

~ Will this book be too hard for me?

- Are there five or more words on a page that I don't know or am unsure of?
- Is this book confusing and hard to understand by myself?
- When I read it aloud, does it sound choppy and slow?

If most of their answers were "yes," this book is too hard. They should wait awhile before they read this book. Give the book another try later, or read the book with them or to them.
