As daylight savings time approaches, it is important to ensure your child is getting enough rest. Here are some tips to help with sleep schedules this spring.

- \*Focus on going to sleep rather than waking up.
- \*If possible, put kids to bed slightly earlier the week prior to daylight savings time.
- \*Shut off screens and devices 1-2 hours before bedtime.
- \*Keep a consistent bedtime routine
